DO NOT RIDE ON SIDEWALKS



DRIVERS MUST GIVE CYCLISTS 4 FT WHEN PASSING

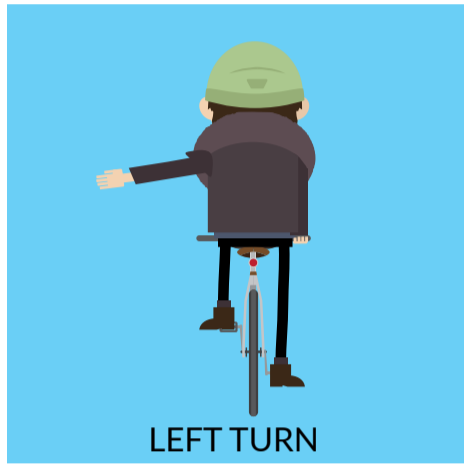


DRIVERS MAY CROSS YELLOW LINE TO GIVE CYCLISTS ROOM, IF SAFE!



Bicyclists should wear a helmet for safety purposes.

KNOW YOUR HAND SIGNALS & use 1,000 ft in advance!



BICYCLES & MOTOR VEHICLES FOLLOW THE SAME TRAFFIC LAWS!

You are subject to DWI and Traffic Laws: In Colorado these statues are found in C.R.S. 42-4-1301 & 42-4-1412



Don't Drink & Ride



Comply to traffic signs

WARN OTHER USERS WITH AN AUDIBLE SIGNAL



STICK TO THE RIGHT-HAND SIDE OF THE PATH



YOU MAY RIDE TWO ABBREAST IF TRAFFIC IS NOT IMPEDED



ALLOW SPACE BETWEEN YOU AND A PARKED CAR



YOU MAY LOCK YOUR BIKE ON A SIDEWALK UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.



MUST HAVE FRONT WHITE LIGHT AT NIGHT. (VISIBLE LIGHT OF 500FT)



MUST HAVE REAR RED LIGHT OR REFLECTOR. (VISIBLE UP TO 600FT)



YOU MAY RIDE ON THE LEFT SIDE ON A ONE WAY ROAD
